

EQUIPMENT FOR SUMMER CAMP

The suggested equipment will help to make the great adventure more convenient and comfortable for Scouts. **All items should be marked with the Scout's name and "T876" in permanent marker.**

WEAR

- Complete Class A uniform (shirt, shorts, socks, belt)
- Comfortable hiking shoes
- Scout appropriate hat
- Swim trunks under uniform on departure
 - Swim test will be taken upon arrival

CARRY IN POCKETS

- Pocket knife (blade 3" or less) not too valuable!
- Handkerchief
- Wallet with money

IN DUFFLE BAG

- Cot (8 to 10 inches tall)
- Sleeping bag or sheets with blanket
- Pillow
- Extra shoes (no open toed shoes)
- Bag for dirty clothes
- Extra swim trunks (nylon shorts/shirts work best at camp)
- Extra shirts (T-shirts, minimum 1 per day)
- Extra shorts/pants (minimum 1 per 2 days, no cutoffs)
- Extra underwear (minimum 1 per day)
- Extra pair of scout socks
- Sweat shirt or light jacket
- Sleep wear (gym shorts, etc)
- Sandals for shower
- 25-50 feet of nylon rope
- 2-4 clothes pins
- OA Sash for Friday night

IN RED PACK

- Towel
- Sack lunch with can drink (no glass containers)
- Sun screen
- Poncho

TOILET KIT

- Washcloth
- 2 towels
- Metal mirror
- Non-aerosol insect repellent
- Deodorant
- Shampoo
- Soap
- Toothbrush and toothpaste
- Sun screen

MISCELLANEOUS

- Watch
- **Water bottle!!!**
- Notebook and pencil
- Individual first aid kit
- Boy Scout Handbook
- Sun glasses (inexpensive)
- 3 large trash bags
- Flashlight & extra batteries
- Combination lock or key lock with extra key

OPTIONAL

- Mosquito net & frame
- Camera
- Camp stool (recommended)
- Ground cloth for interior of tent (recommended)
- Bible or prayer book

SPECIAL CLASS or MERIT BADGE NEEDS

- Long sleeve shirt and long pants (swimming)
- Golf bag (only if taking golf merit badge)
- Compass (1st Year Scouts or Scouts taking orienteering)
- Fishing Pole for Fishing MB classes
- Survival Kit for Wilderness Survival MB (see MB info)

HOW TO PACK

Scouts should pack each day's clothes in a single large Zip-lock bag (socks, shorts, t-shirt). This keeps the duffle bag organized and makes getting ready in the morning much easier!

WHAT NOT TO BRING

Scouts should not bring any of the items listed in the Troop Handbook as prohibited. Additionally, Scouts may not bring water guns or other water squirting toys. **Nothing which you can not afford to lose should be brought to camp.**

MONEY

Scouts should have spending money for:

- trading post items (snacks, extra T-shirts, etc),
- handicraft projects, including handicraft merit badges, (\$5 - \$15, see MB info link)
- rifle rounds (\$1 for ten shots)
- shotgun shells (\$1 for 4 shells)
- Archery merit badge needs \$5 for arrow kit
